About the role

The Video and Motion Graphics Editor will be responsible for creating polished video assets for Minderoo Foundation. Primarily focussed on editing and motion graphics, this position will be responsible for creating a large volume of content for a range of channels including (but not limited to) social media, broadcast news, internal presentations, and livestreams. Working closely with our videographer, the Video and Motion Graphics Editor will need to be able to produce a high volume of quick turnaround projects

Your key responsibilities will include:

- Editing of all content, including the addition of graphics, supers, subtitles, and sound
- Creation of high quality and visually engaging animations, particularly for social media
- Stay on top of latest social media video trends and editing techniques for emerging formats (e.g. Reels etc.)
- Developing a suite of motion graphic assets (including editable .MOGRT files.) in line with brand guidelines (transitions, kinetic type style etc.)
- Support with filming (in partnership with our videographer) in a range of environments such as events, interviews, press conferences and more
- Technical set up and filming of live streams
- Preparing b-roll footage packages for news media

About you

To be successful in this role you will have:

- Formal education in TV, Production, Film, Fine Arts or similar (Bachelor's degree, diploma or certificate) or equivalent experience
- High-level proficiency with Adobe Creative Suite, particularly After Effects, InDesign, Photoshop & Premiere Pro
- Strong ability to create visually compelling and original motion graphics and animation
- Deep understanding of post-production techniques
- Strong background in editing highly engaging content that includes graphics, supers and animation



- Experience creating social media content and demonstrated understanding of the nuance of social media content vs. traditional media
- Demonstrated creative ability, particularly in terms of crafting a story and trying new editing techniques
